As a Citizens' Electric customer, you own and are responsible to maintain the electric 'service entrance' to your home. The following illustrations show typical overhead and underground services and who (you or Citizens') is responsible to maintain each part.

RED equipment in the diagrams is owned and maintained by Citizens' Electric.

GREEN equipment in the diagrams is yours and it is your responsibility to maintain it.

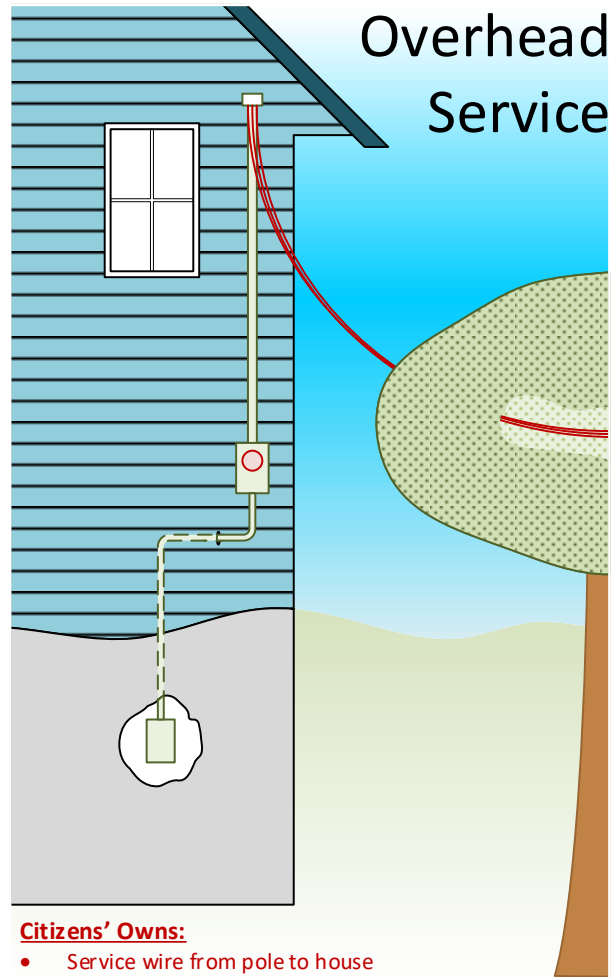
If you have questions or concerns about your responsibilities or the safety of your electric service, please contact Citizens' Electric, we are happy to assist you!

Citizens' Owns:

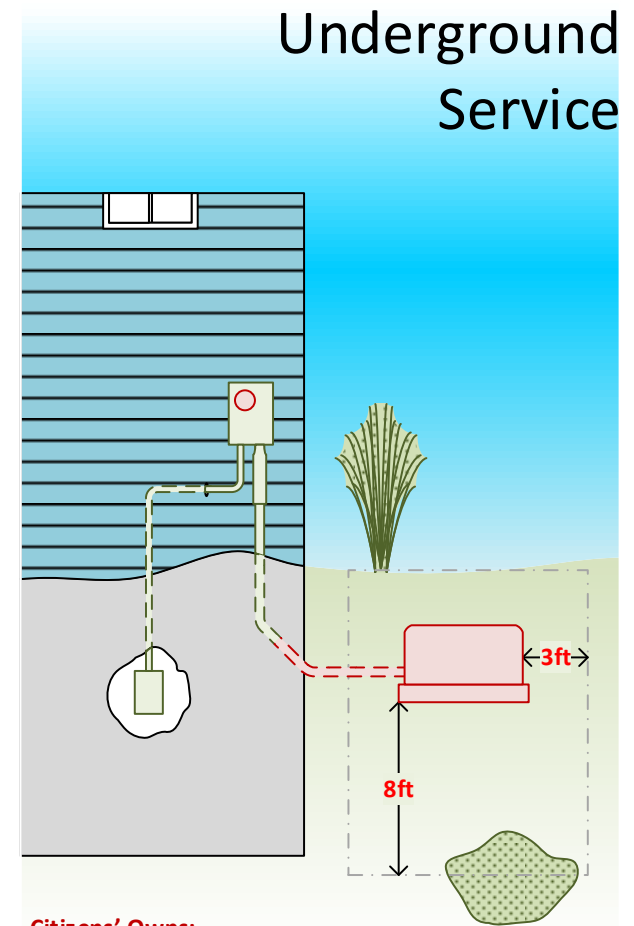
- Service wire from pole to house
- Electric Meter

Customer Owns:

- Weatherhead & Cables on side of house
- Meter Base
- Cables inside house
- Main Disconnect and Panelbox

Customer is Responsible to

- Maintain customer-owned equipment
- Provide clear & safe access to Citizens'-owned equipment
- Maintain trees/vegetation near service wire



Citizens' Owns:

- Pad-mounted transformer or pedestal
- Service wire & conduit from transformer to house
- Electric Meter

Customer Owns:

- Cables and conduits attached to side of house
- Meter Base
- Cables inside house
- Main Disconnect and Panelbox

Customer is Responsible to:

- Maintain customer-owned equipment
- Provide clear & safe access to Citizens'-owned equipment
- Maintain clear space around transformer
(8ft in front, 3ft on sides and back)
